### Introduction

We are delighted that you are attending the Alliance Peacemaking Conflict Coaching Certification (CC) Training. Whatever your motive in coming, you can be sure that God knew that you would be here and He has plans for you!

The mission of Alliance Peacemaking (AP) is to change the culture of the Alliance Church when dealing with conflict in a way that honors God and is founded on biblical principles. AP uses the biblically-based model developed by Ken Sande, founder of Peacemaker Ministries, as found in his seminal book, *The Peacemaker*. This equips you to help others work through conflicts in a God-honoring manner, but you first must thoroughly understand the concepts in your own life and what God does through conflict before you can ever hope to assist someone else. Therefore, it is critical that you read and digest *The Peacemaker* and rigorously apply the principles and questions to a conflict or relational struggle your own life as a foundation before you attend the CC training.

The preparatory homework asks questions for each chapter that you need to answer in writing and in depth; brevity is not a virtue here. This homework is confidential and will not be shared unless you choose to do so. You cannot do it at the last minute, however, and hope to be adequately prepared to take the CC seminar. Your instructors will be counting on the fact that you know the material and have applied it in your own life.
